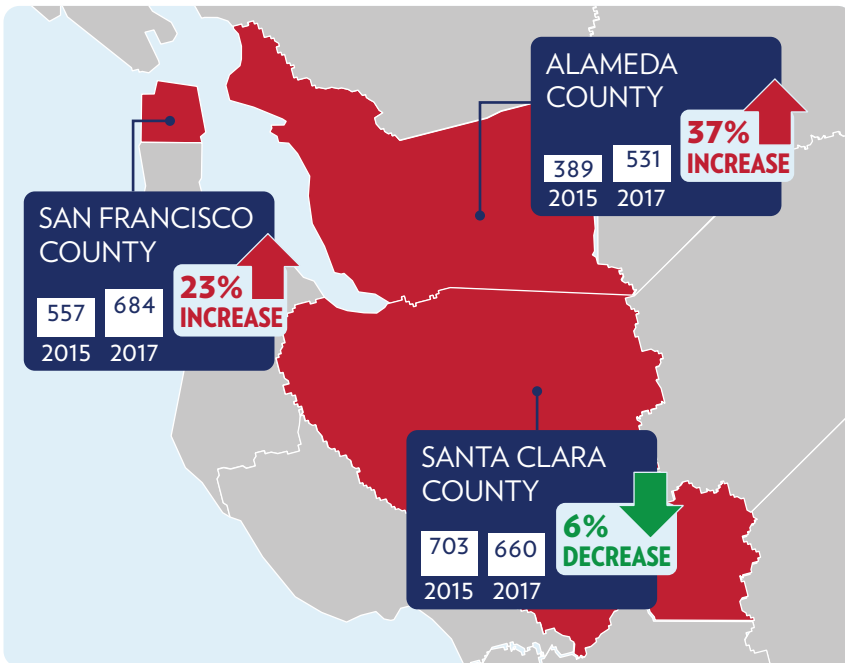

## PRIMARY CAUSES OF VETERAN HOMELESSNESS

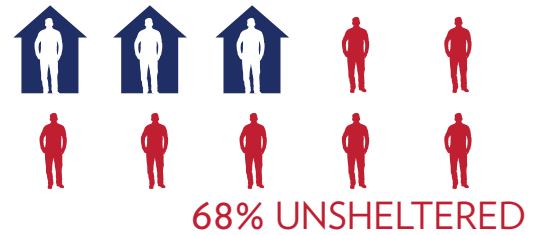


## HOMELESS VETERAN POPULATION IN THE BAY AREA: 2015-2017

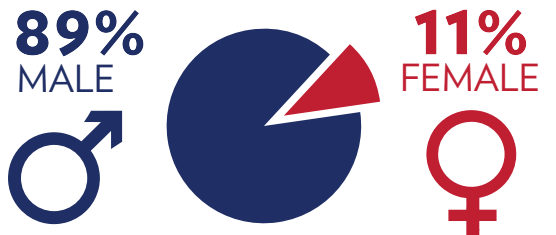


## SHELTERED/UNSHELTERED HOMELESS VETERANS

## LOCAL FUNDING COMMITTED TO END VETERAN HOMELESSNESS

The Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors has authorized an additional \$1.5 million a year in housing and services for homeless veterans and \$1.16 million in a landlord incentive program for landlords to rent units to veterans. The City of San Jose will be committing up to \$6 million for new housing opportunities that could serve more than 100 veterans. The Housing Authority annually has up to \$7.445 million available through Veterans Affairs (federally supported) Supportive Housing (VASH) vouchers.
